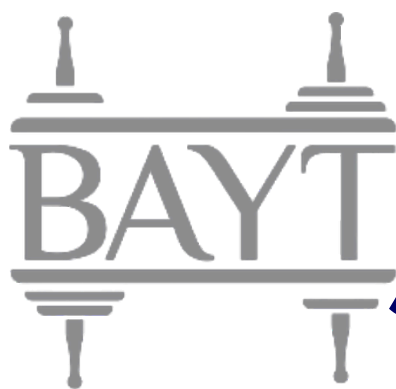

Paying the Rent on Time

Question: I read your column last week about the Biblical commandment to pay a laborer on time. I realize that the stakes are quite high, so I'm prepared to fulfill this halakhah carefully and always pay my workers as soon as services are rendered. I'm wondering what the parameters of this halakhah are. Specifically, does this mitzvah also require me to pay for rented goods on time – such as a car or appliance rental – or does it only apply to paying for labor? Furthermore, does it apply equally to all goods, including real estate, such that if I fail to pay my rent on time, I'm in violation of this halakhah? Finally, what if the person from whom I'm renting the goods or am receiving services is a non-Jew – do the laws of paying on time apply to a non-Jew as well?

Answer: All good questions. First, let's clarify how far this halakhah of "Pay him on that self-same day" (Deut. 24:14-15) extends. The Gemara (Bava Metzia 111b) looks at the verse, "Do not oppress the laborer (by paying him late)," and notes that the verse states that the worker "is upon your land." The Gemara derives from this phrase that anything that is upon your land is subject to this prohibition. That is, one doesn't just violate this law when failing to pay a worker; he is in violation if he fails to pay on time for ANYTHING that is "upon the land." Thus, if a person rents an animal or utensils, he must pay for those items immediately when payment is due. If he delays payment, he is violating this commandment.

Regarding real estate, the Shulchan Aruch (CM 339:1) quotes the Tur that some maintain that if one fails to pay for rented real estate on time, he is NOT in violation of this halakhah, since the verse states that this law applies only to things that are UPON the land – that is, workers and chattel – but not land itself. In reading this, one might conclude that failure to pay one's rent on time is free and clear from this violation.

However, in his commentary to Shulchan Aruch, the Ketzos HaChoshen writes that one is only free from violation if he rents actual land, such as farmland or a parking lot. But if a person rents a house or an apartment, there is a debate in the poskim as to whether a structure above ground is viewed as true "real estate" for this halakhah. Because the materials of the house started off as lumber, drywall, studs, concrete,

rebar, etc., which were all later attached to the ground, it is unclear whether or not something that was originally detached from the ground and was later attached is judged for all halakhic matters as real estate.

Additionally, Sefer Yereim (263) cites from the Midrash Sifra that one IS in violation of this law even when renting pure real estate. For this reason, Ketzos HaChoshen and others rule that one must be stringent in this law for house and apartment rentals also. If one fails to pay his rent on time, he MAY be in violation of this Biblical law.

If a person rents a furnished house or apartment, this only amplifies his violation, because in that case, he is certainly renting chattel (the furniture), thus clearly violating the Torah when he doesn't pay on time.

Regarding the question: when the landlord is not Jewish, does one incur a violation for failing to pay the rent on time? The Gemara (ibid.) cites a Beraisa which states that one IS in violation of the positive commandment of "Pay him on that self-same day" even if the person in question is a non-Jew (the Beraisa concedes that for failing to pay a Jew, one incurs an additional negative commandment).

We also observe that when a frum Jew fails to pay a non-Jew on time for services rendered, he is making a Chillul Hashem (I know this from personal experience, since I was once called by a non-Jew who was in tears regarding someone in our community who avoided paying him for services rendered. He could not understand how a "religious" Jew who observes the Bible could behave this way. I did my best to mitigate the Chillul Hashem damage).

One final point: The Arizal looked at the words of the commandment, "Pay him on that self-same day," which in Hebrew are, "B'Yomo Titen Secharo." Taking the first letter of these three words spells the word "Shabbos." When one pays for goods and services on time, not only has he fulfilled a very important Torah mitzvah; he is also rewarded that his Shabbos will be filled with additional spiritual force and blessing for all aspects of his soul.

Let Me Tell You A Story...



The Power of Our Prayers

Some tell stories to put the children to sleep. Jews tell stories to wake the children up.

Rebbe Nachman of Breslov

A group of young yeshiva students from Machane Retzufos in San Antonio, Texas were on a class trip visiting the US-Mexico border in Eagle Pass, Texas. What happened to them turned a regular trip into a miraculous story proving the power of tefillah.

The boys, led by Shloime Zionce, were visiting the area near the Texas-Mexico border when they encountered a local woman who owned a pecan farm. Struck by their faith and background, she approached them, sharing her deep connection to the land and the struggles her farm had been facing due to a severe two-year drought:

"We've been praying for rain, but nothing has worked," she told the group. "I know the Jewish people have a special connection to God, and I wonder if you could say a prayer for us."

Moved by her plea, Shloime, somewhat humorously, led the boys in a short Mi Sheberach-style tefillah in English, asking for rain to help the struggling crops. The woman then asked if the boys could sing a song from Psalms, which she said she often read herself. Perhaps doubting their ability to actually bring rain for this woman and her pecan farm, some of the boys sang "Esa Eina" with a bit of a smile and a smirk.

The woman told the boys that the weather forecast showed no rain in sight, but she thanked them for their prayers and promised to let them know if anything changed. The group continued their trip, heading deeper into the border area before making their way back to San Antonio, where they were staying, later that day.

To their surprise, the woman called them that evening, overwhelmed with emotion. "You won't believe this," she said, her voice trembling with tears. "It's pouring rain here. The skies have opened up, and it's a downpour like we haven't seen in years. We've been praying for this rain for so long, and now it's finally here." The woman attributed the rain to the boys' tefillos, saying, "I see now when God sends His army -- His soldiers -- things happen. Your prayers made a difference."

These boys did not take their prayers seriously but Hashem clearly did. How much do we underestimate the power of our own prayers?

Recognizing the power of our prayers this Elul, take a moment to make our tefillos count. Hashem is listening.
