Dressed for the Day – While some choose to wear white, any colour or style of modest clothing is entirely acceptable. Please remember that Halacha prohibits wearing leather footwear on Yom Kippur. Everyone is asked to honour this holiest day by wearing non-leather shoes. If you mistakenly arrive wearing leather footwear, please remove it.

At Your Service – *Kol Nidrei* evening services will take place in the **Main Sanctuary**. On Yom Kippur Eve, three concurrent Youth Programs, organized by age, will be offered -- all led by our fantastic, responsible counselors!

Child's Play - By Registration Only! – Our exciting Youth Program is packed with games, entertainers, snacks, and food arts, and runs from 10:00 AM to 2:00 PM. Children **MUST** be registered in advance to attend; regrettably, children without prior registration will not be admitted. Please note: There is no youth program or babysitting during Ne'ilah.

Open Doors | Reserved Seats – Seating in the Main Sanctuary is nearly sold out and remains in effect throughout the entire holiday. In keeping with our open-door policy, everyone is welcome. However, guests are respectfully asked not to occupy someone else's labelled seat without permission. Visitors may stand along the back and sides of the Shul.

Staying Safe – Despite the overflow crowds, due to security on **Kol Nidrei Eve**, **ONLY the south entrance** will be open and monitored by armed security personnel to ensure everyone's safety.

We anticipate spending this holiest day of the year safely and joyously. We hope that our **Tefillot** help bring us abundant health, happiness, peace, and prosperity.
