Rabbi Yuval Cherlow is a graduate of Yeshivat Har Etzion and a retired IDF Major. He co-founded Yeshivat Orot Shaul, named in honour of Shaul Koschitzky, and serves as head of the Tzohar Rabbinical Organization's Ethics Center. He is also the founder of Tzohar Ad Me'ah V'Esrin, which provides ethical guidance on end-of-life decisions.

A prolific author on Halakha, Tanakh and Jewish thought, Rabbi Cherlow has published more than 60,000 online responsa and serves on national ethics committees in Israel. He is currently in Toronto as a Mizrahi scholar-in-residence.

PARSHA MATTERS by RABBI ELLIOTT DIAMOND

ROOM FOR BOTH

Towards the end of his life, Moshe tells the Jewish people, “Ki lo davar reik hu mikem” — “It is not an empty thing for you.” Chazal hear another message in these words: if Torah appears “empty,” mikem — perhaps the limitation is in our own understanding.

The Rambam applies this idea to Torah study. He advises his son that when he encounters something he cannot understand, he should “leave it in a corner.” Keep learning, keep thinking, and perhaps one day he will return to it with greater understanding.

Perhaps Moshe was giving us a way to approach not only difficult texts, but difficult questions about Hashem, faith and life itself. He knew there would be things we could not explain—tragedies that make no sense, prayers that seem unanswered, and teachings we struggle to understand.

We sometimes think faith requires answers. Perhaps mature faith also requires the ability to live without them.

There is another possibility besides “I understand” and “I reject”: “I don’t understand yet.”

And while the question remains in the corner, we continue to live as committed Jews. We keep Shabbat. We learn Torah. We perform mitzvot. We daven. We remain part of the covenant.

Some questions may eventually be answered. Others may remain with us for a lifetime.

There is room in a committed Jewish heart for both the question and the commitment.
